

**VILLAGE OF MATTAWAN
PARKING ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 9**

An Ordinance regulating the parking of motor and other vehicles on the public streets within the Village of Mattawan to prescribe penalties for the violation of its provision, and to repeal all Ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE VILLAGE OF MATTAWAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Parking Ordinance of the Village of Mattawan", and may be referred to or cited by that title.

SECTION 2.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park or leave standing unattended any motor or other vehicle, whether designed for public or private conveyance in or upon any public street with the Village of Mattawan between the hours of 3 A.M. and 6 A.M. This Ordinance will be in effect from November 1 to April 1 for each respective calendar year.

SECTION 3.

Appropriate signs designating the parking restrictions prescribed by this Ordinance shall be erected on all street of access to the Village of Mattawan, and when so erected shall be deemed notice to all persons, firms and corporations of said parking restrictions.

SECTION 4. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each offense, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. REPEAL CLAUSE.

All Ordinances adopted by the Village of Mattawan deemed in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.

This Ordinance shall become effective on December 29, 1963.
